**Concept:** The project envisages retail and community space at the street level on Milwaukee Avenue and a mix of studio one and two bedrooms units on floors 2 through 7.

Given the trapezoidal corner, the building utilizes the street potential to the fullest, with large expansive storefronts. The upper levels clad in brick veneer provide for generous quantum's of light and ventilation. Given the developers aesthetic preferences, facade expression simultaneously captures the sentiment of the Chicago frame while simultaneously making a conscious attempt to make affordable housing seem generous in all respects. Multiple units take advantage of corner conditions thereby emphasizing the sense of openness.
