Context: These offices were to be the Mumbai headquarters for a Swiss charitable foundation

Concept: The Volkart Foundation is a not for profit organization that has many decades been integrally involved in the economic and social betterment of the impoverished. Being a charitable organization, we were given the mandate to create a subtle interior, at a moderate price with durable long lasting finishes. Our approach was fairly straightforward creating independent workstations with the ability to add modular storage should the need arise. Given the diverse tapestry that is India we carried a two tone veneer effect, with a lighter maple for the work areas and a more demure mahogany for the office cabins and conference areas. Panelling between workstations has intentionally been done with frosted glass to permit natural light as into spaces as possible. Counter tops have been completed with integral solid surfaces.
